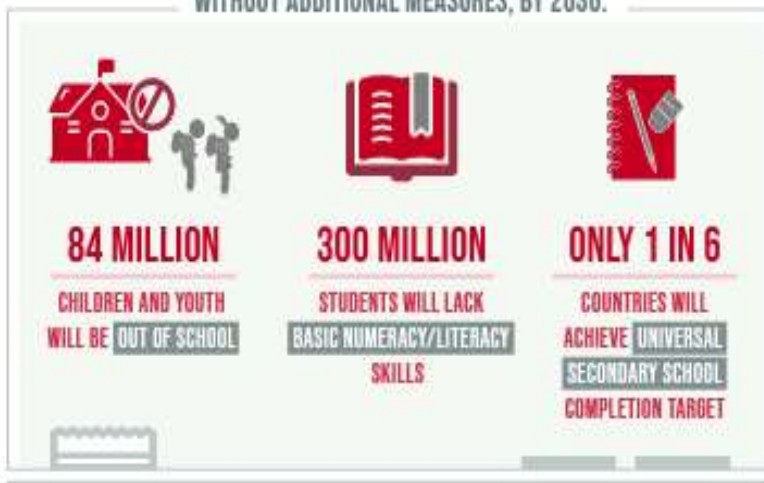

Scholarship Policy

The College is dedicated to attracting and supporting exceptionally talented students in higher education. Scholarships are offered by the institution, government and non-governmental organizations, as well as philanthropists, to ensure that financial constraints do not hinder any student from accessing quality education at the institute. Scholarships are awarded based on both financial need and academic merit, with the aim of providing equal opportunities to all deserving students.

The college provides information to students about various scholarships offered by state and central governments through the website, where relevant details are uploaded. The college takes the following measures to assist deserving and meritorious students in accessing scholarships and free ships:

- The college encourages students to avail governmental and non-governmental scholarships and endowments. Scholarships are offered to deserving and meritorious students across all courses, based on specific criteria. The college has provisions in place to support students who require financial or material assistance for their education, following a standardized procedure.
- To avail this facility, students need to submit their applications to the Scholarship Cell or their respective Heads of Departments (HoDs). The Scholarship Cell or HoD carefully reviews the applications based on the applicant's academic performance, economic background, and category. The recommended applications are then forwarded to the respective In charge for further consideration.
- The final decision on scholarships is made by the Director, taking into account the recommendations of the Scholarship Cell, HoD, and Incharge. The college ensures that applications are submitted within the timeline specified by the government/college for scholarship schemes.

The College offers two kinds of Scholarships:

(a) Institutional Scholarships & Awards.

(b) Government Scholarships.

(a) Institutional Scholarships & Awards

Late Dalbeer Singh Memorial Scholarship

Rs. 1500/- per annum for faculty wise two applicants (in order of merit). from Post Graduate Departments of the college. this scholarship funded by Late Dalbeer Singh Smriti Vikas Samiti Rajendragram.

(b) Government Scholarships/Yojna

i. Mukhyamantri Medhavi Vidhyarthi Yojna (MMVY)

Scholarship scheme for meritorious students of 12th class of Madhya Pradesh.

ii. Gaon ki Beti Yojna

(Rs. 5,000/- per annum per girl applicant) only for those students who have passed Higher Secondary examination from the school situated in rural area/Gram Panchayat /Janpad Panchayat. It will be given for three years to eligible students who will mandatorily apply in 1st year. Renewal will take place in 2nd & 3rd year after submission of the forms. This scholarship can be given with any other scholarship.

iii. Pratibha Kiran Yojna

(Rs. 5,000/- per annum per girl applicant) Eligibility – 1st division in class 12th, BPL category, school from urban area it will be given for three years to eligible students who apply in 1st year of course. Renewal will take place in 2nd & 3rd year after submission of the forms.

iv. Vikramaditya Yojna

(Rs. 2,500/- per annum per boy applicant of General Category) Eligibility – 1st division in class 12th, annual income of parent less than Rs. 56,000/-

v. Nih shakt Jan Scholarship funded by Samajik Nyay Vibhag

(Rs 200/- per month per boy/girl applicant admitted to computer/Management Courses for M.P. domicile and parent income up to Rs.1 lakh.

vi. Post Matric Scholarship for SC/ST/ OBC Minority and Nishakht, Ghumakkar students.

vii. Gramin Awasiya Yojna funded by Adim Jati Kalyan Vibhag (Rs 2000/- per month for SC/ST students).

viii. Awagaman Yojna Bhatta

Conveyance Allowance (Rs 5/- per day per girl student – Rs. 500/- for 100 days and Rs 1000/- for 200 days only in one session) can be given with any other type of scholarship/award.

ix. Lalima Yojna

The government of M.P. has initiated Lalima Yojna for girl's students to monitor and keep track of the anemia and hemoglobin levels.

Note:

- (1) Govt. Scholarships will be given as per Govt. rules.
- (2) Application Forms will be available on website of Scholarship Portal. Students can fill Online/offline forms and submit.
- (3) Students will be eligible for only one scholarship among all categories except Gaon ki Beti Yojna, Avagaman Bhatta.
